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MSP changes starting June 1, 2024

In the past the state followed a "buy-in" agreement with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Under federal changes the agreements are being rolled into the Social Security Act.

In a nutshell there will be a new category for MSP eligibility in addition to the current QMB,SLMB,and ALMB categories.

The new category will use the initials NMB which stands for <u>Not</u> categorically eligible <u>Michigan Beneficiary</u>.

April 2024

NMB eligibility criteria

- Individuals who are eligible for Medicare and full coverage Medicaid may be eligible under the new NMB category for state payment of the Medicare part A/B premiums.
- Facilities should expect to see adjustments to the PPAs starting in June 2024.
- Connected to this change is the enforcement of the Medicaid state plan which requires an individual who is potentially eligible for Medicare to apply for Medicare as a condition of Medicaid eligibility.

April 2024

Plan First

- Will be assigned to almost everyone as there is no age or asset test for the program, only an income test.
- It is not full coverage Medicaid however a person enrolled in Plan First is considered a Medicaid beneficiary.
- As a Medicaid beneficiary any negative changes to their coverage must have timely (10 days) notice.
